

MAJOR ACTIVITIES UNDER CSR BUDGET 2025-26



1. Girl Empowerment Mission Residential Workshop

Forty girls participated in a four-week residential GEM workshop, where they developed confidence-building skills, digital literacy, self-defense techniques, and strong values to help them become more confident, empowered, and independent. Sixteen girls received scholarships under GEM to as financial support for their school fees, helping them continue their studies without financial stress. Forty GEM girls were given bicycles to help them travel to school safely and regularly, making their daily commute easier and encouraging continued education.

2. Distribution of Stationery Kits and Umbrellas

To encourage children to attend school regularly and support their learning, 1,900 stationery kits and umbrellas were distributed in government schools of nearby villages. This small support has made a big difference in their daily school life.

3. BALA Painting in Schools

Around 10,000 sq. ft. of BALA (Building as Learning Aid) painting was completed on the walls of government school premises. These colorful, educational paintings help make learning fun, interactive, and engaging for children.

4. Installation of Hand Pumps

To help villages get easy access to clean drinking water, 80 hand pumps were installed in nearby rural areas. This has reduced the daily struggle for water and improved health and hygiene conditions for the local community.

9. Provision of nutritious food items for distribution to tuberculosis patients under the TB-Free Mission.

This initiative aims to provide monthly assistance to 100 tuberculosis (TB) patients, ensuring continuous nutritional and care support to improve their health outcomes throughout the one-year treatment period.

10. Eye Camp

A total of 123 patients were registered for the eye camp. Out of 30 patients identified for surgery, 26 successfully underwent cataract (motiyabind) operations using (IOL Implant) laser treatment.

11. Assistive Aids & Appliances Distribution for Divyangjan Camp through ALIMCO

Through CSR support, a total of 486 patients were registered for the distribution of assistive devices and devices for persons with disabilities. After proper assessment and verification, 348 eligible beneficiaries were provided with the necessary assistive devices, which will improve their mobility, independence, and overall quality of life.

12. Assistant Fashion Designer exhibition

Through CSR support, an Assistant Fashion Designer Exhibition was organized to provide a platform for trainees to showcase their creativity, technical skills, and innovative fashion designs. The exhibition enabled the trainees to present their work, demonstrate their learning outcomes, and gain confidence while exploring opportunities for employment and entrepreneurship in the fashion sector

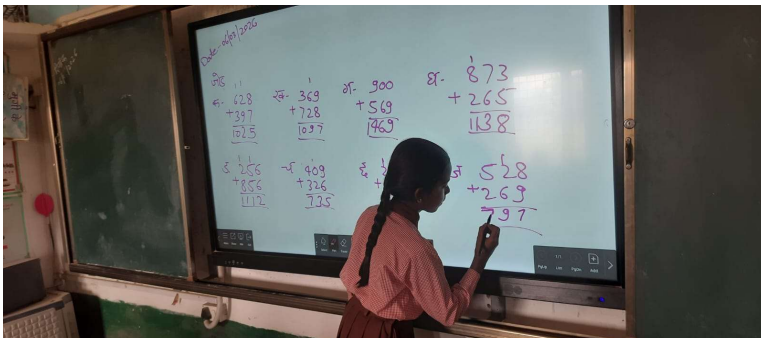
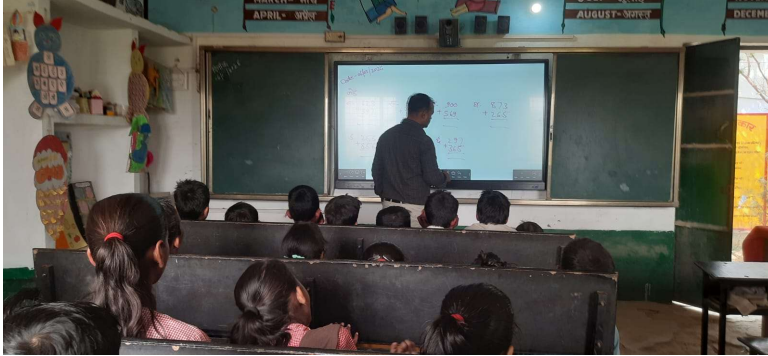
EDUCATION – INSTALLATION OF 5 KW OFF GRID SOLAR SYSTEM

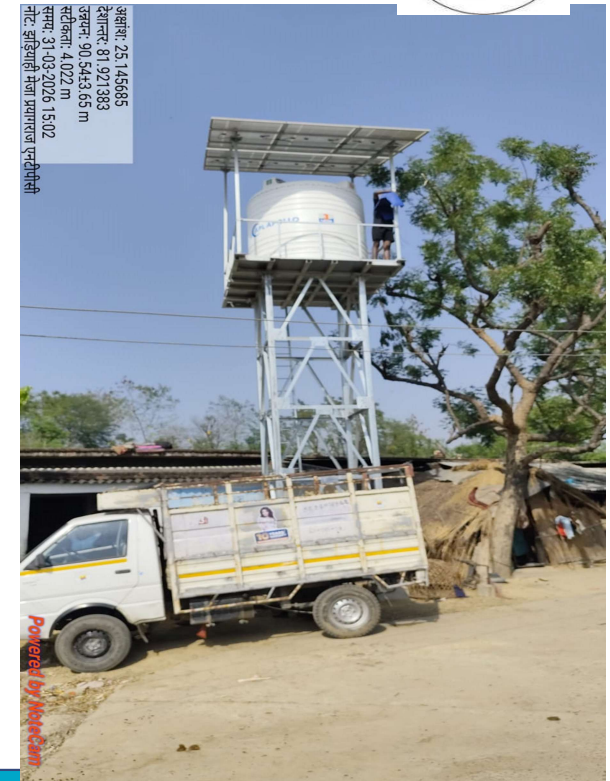
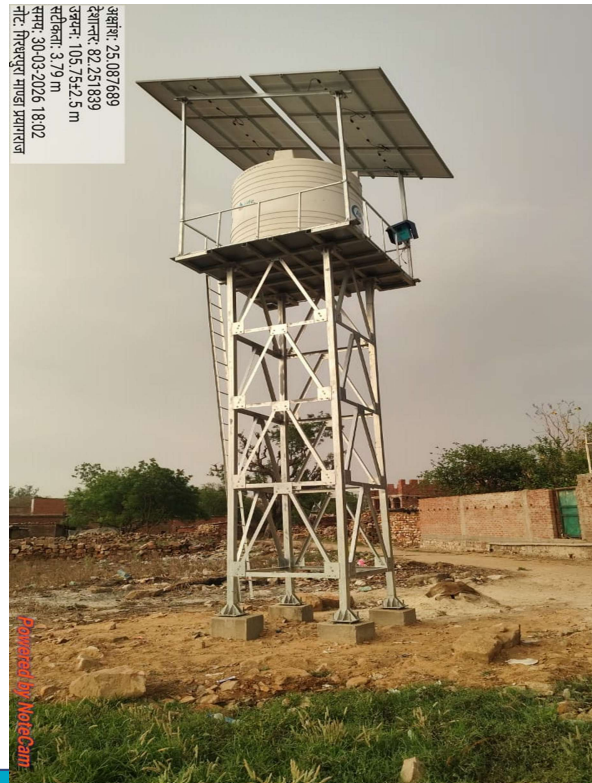
